Murfreesboro, TN, 20 July 2021

The meeting was called to order by President Watson at 14:00. Eddie Phillips opened the meeting with a prayer and John Tallent led the pledge.

Welcome: President Watson welcomed all in attendance and thanked all the vendors.

Minutes: The minutes from the Gatlinburg meeting were approved by motion during the Board meeting.

<u>Treasurer's Report:</u> Treasurer's Report: Eddie Phillips reported that there is \$85,945.59 in the General Account. The Conference account has \$48,238.72. The Conference account is a bit misconceiving due to being in the middle of the Conference. The General Account Budget was amended by a motion to increase the Fire Service Coalition line item to \$5,400. All in all, things look very good.

<u>Conference Report:</u> James Fountain reported a record number of about 165 attendees. The Pre-Conf NFA classes had 65+ attendees. Thanks to James and MFRD for their hard work.
